### **Accountability & Commitment:**

Two of our key aims are to work with local church leaders, and provide a very practical training for our students. Both of these aims are fulfilled in part through the student's Helps Ministry Requirement (HMR). We require students attending Coventry Bible College to complete at least 100 hours of practical ministry service in *their* local church. There are key ministry areas we want each student to gain experience in during their Level 1 training, and these areas are all service based (Usher, Administration, Cleaning Facilities, Assisting the Pastor, setting up for meetings, etc.). You, or the person you designate as their HMR Mentor, will have the final say in what the student must do. The most important part of the HMR Mentors job is completing a short activity report a few times throughout the year to ensure the student is fulfilling their duties in an efficient and helpful manner. By recommending the student you are agreeing to be, or provide, a HMR Mentor for the students and assist the student in fulfilling their Helps Ministry Requirement.

#### **Church Attendance Policy:**

All students must maintain active participation in their local church, and they are **NOT** permitted to change churches while enrolled as a student of Coventry Bible College except under very special circumstances and only with their Pastor's full support.
